The word "liturgy" literally means "the work of the people." In ancient Greece it would refer to large public works projects like parks or even amphitheaters. Today it is a helpful reminder that the words we use in worship are meant to be for all of God's people.

We embody this root meaning in special ways here at Northminster, with lay leaders providing much of the liturgy we use in worship each week.

But it is during the special seasons of the church, particularly the high holy days of Holy Week and Easter, that I am reminded "the work of the people" to bring to life the story of our faith extends well beyond the words of our worship.

The liturgy of this congregation comes alive in so many ways.

—The palms and flowers arranged with care and placed with intention over the course of the week.

—The food prepared and hospitality offered that created space for us to gather.

—The Lenten devotional containing the reflections and insights of so many within the congregation, and so thoughtfully assembled.

—The artistic installations created by our children, or the cross by the road with the stone path leading to it, adorned with fabric to signal the time of the season and finally with flowers brought by the congregation as signs of new life.

—The special services that help us reenact the story of our faith in intimate detail.

—The music, lead by our choir and punctuated by our beautiful organ, that give special voice to the parts of the passion that are beyond words.

And too many others to name.

There is a liturgy to the common life we share here at Northminster, and it is during these central seasons of our year together that we are reminded just how much it is a work, an offering, a blessing of all God's people in this place. SHD





ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM FOR NORTHMINSTER BIBLE CAMP July 19-21, 2024
