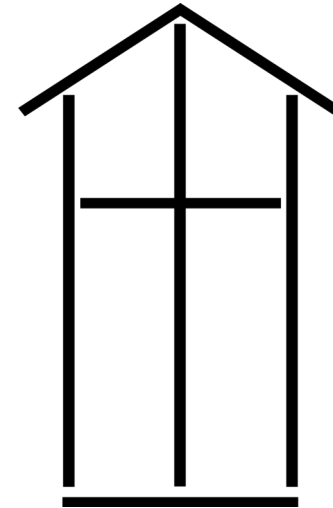
Lord, make us instruments of your peace:
