Now. Here. This.

Over the past few days I have found myself thinking a lot about prayer.

On the one hand, I cannot remember a time when prayer was not a part of my life. Table blessings and prayers before bedtime were an unquestioned part of my childhood, and even in those young adult years when I wasn't sure if I was running toward or away from it, prayer was a part of the faith I could not leave alone (or that couldn't leave me alone?).

But through the years my vision of what prayer is or can be has expanded in equal measure to my understanding of who God is.

I now see prayer as being less about transaction and more about formation. It's not so much about us informing God of our innermost needs, thoughts and emotions—however, voicing these things can be important, as they are often revealing for us.

Prayer is finally more about what God would say to us, in the silence we hold and even as we reflect on our own words.

Of course, our own private prayers are one thing, but praying in community with others is another. In communal prayer, or "corporate" prayer, we join our hearts and minds as we direct them to God. While it is probably useful to be clear in our aims for our own private prayers, this becomes especially important when praying with others.

Over the course of our Sunday worship we lift many prayers, each with a different purpose. We ask God's presence in our worship. We confess our sins and ask for forgiveness. We ask God's blessing as we depart. But in the focal prayer, in our tradition, the "pastoral prayer," we lift our intercessions to God—asking God to move or act in some way, for us and others.

This is a tricky thing, to pray on another's behalf, and something I labor over each week. On some level, it is impossible to speak for another to God. Yet this is among the responsibilities we give to our worship leaders, trusting them to offer words to God that represent the heart of the congregation, even in an inherently imperfect way, and with all the necessary grace.

When this trust is broken it can be a painful thing. Sadly, this happened this past Sunday with our guest worship leader. This was disappointing and unexpected, and I am sorry for the discomfort and pain it caused to those present.

One thing this experience has illuminated—as mistakes can be our best teachers—is just how powerful and sacred our shared prayers can be; what happens in and around us when we direct our intentions toward shared joys, concerns, and hopes. It is the very heart of community.

Another gift of our shared prayers is that we commit to offering them every week, trusting that what happens to us in prayer happens best over the long haul. So until this Sunday, and with special gratitude for this community of prayer,


