As of September 30, 2024, (75% of the year), we have collected \$1,332,114, or 66.49% of our budgeted receipts.

While our expenses have increased since last year, our income has increased more, leaving us almost \$150,000 better off this September than we were in 2023.

As with any aging facility, we have done the things necessary to maintain our facilities, all without incurring external debt:

Our Roof Replacement and Exterior Restoration project was completed on time, and we have funded this through your gifts, pledges, and facility reserves. Thus far, we have received a total of \$2,410,227 in cash and pledges thanks to your inspiring generosity. Still, our goal remains to raise all the funds needed for the project and replenish our contingency fund, which requires an additional \$310,844.

We recently have had both chillers replaced for our air conditioning system (\$231,500) that will help maintain the comfort we enjoy.

Our upper and lower courtyards need immediate repair due to drainage issues. This project has been approved by the finance committee and the Deacons and will be presented to the congregation for approval on November 10.

The mission work of Northminster continues on a strong level funded through the annual budget and your donations. In addition to our budgeted missions and denominational gifts, we have been able to contribute over \$30,000 in disaster relief to our partners in the region effected by hurricanes Helene and Milton. We have also been able to disburse and additional \$40,000+ in direct assistance to those in our community through the Pastors' Benevolence fund, which is funded entirely from designated gifts from within the congregation.

If you have made a pledge for 2025, we appreciate your participation. If you have not pledged, please prayerfully consider doing so now. We rely on pledges for budgeting purposes so that we can continue to fully fund the important ministries of our church.
